DUAL CREDIT/ DUAL ENROLLMENT AND TESTING INFORMATION AND UPDATES

- I will be visiting classrooms the first part of November to walk students through the spring registration process. The deadline for enrolling in a spring dual enrollment class is **December 1, 2024.**
- MWSU will send students a bill for fall classes (College Algebra and Chem II) that will be due November 1. This bill can be payed through your GoldLink Account.
- College Writing I students: You need to access and pay the bill through
 your MBTS login or call the Financial office to pay as soon as possible.
- Sociology students: Your FACTS account will be charged for this course on September 15th. The spring dual enrollment offering will be Intro to Philosophy.
- All CCU classes will be billed through FACTS on September 15th.
- Fall ACT is October 14 and 15. <u>Sign up here.</u> Deadline to sign up is October 2nd.
- All Juniors will take the PSAT on October 28th.

JUNIOR FALL CHECKLIST

- Sign up to take the ACT on October 15 (deadline to sign up is October 10.)
- Look at the various college and career exploration field trips (above) and sign up for ones you would like to attend.
- All Juniors will take the PSAT on **October 28th.** This is an important test, as it serves as the qualifier for the National Merit Scholarship Program.
- Make plans to visit any colleges you are interested in this year. Most students find it is easier to attend a college visit during a sports off season. These absences are excused and can be approved by Ms. Klundt. You can schedule your visits online by visiting the school's website.
